

Reflexive Journal:

Putting together the interview schedule: helped by previous research but also my own experiences -what would be useful for the research but also the service to know about this topic to help provide some useful feedback and follow up

Recruiting participants: possibility of those who I am more familiar with to feel like they should participate to help me out

Wanting to give the 'right' answers to the questions

Will there be more of those in my immediate team coming forward

Spread across PWP's PT's and HiCBT's participating

Interviews:

Not expanding too much on terminology due to knowing this

Am I not expanding enough as I understand the topic so may not be getting enough detail.

Have an open conversation beforehand with interviewees what my role in this is as an interviewer, so I may ask them to expand more on certain aspects

My own view points around the difficulties if working with LTC patients -does that mean I have been not exploring the positives enough

Analysis:

-having an idea in my mind of themes – being careful not to then dismiss any other data

- having to be critical – felt a bit uncomfortable – almost like I was betraying my service – needing to take a step back and be balanced in my arguments.
