Interview Questions and Prompts for Pilot interview

Interview Questions

- 1. Can you explain what do you understand by group learning?

 Prompt: To see whether the participant's understanding of group learning matches with cooperative group learning. Explore their understanding of key elements in group learning, e.g. positive interdependence, individual accountability etc
- 2. Tell me about your group assignment.
- 3. What is required in group work?
- 4. Tell me how you all work together for the assignment?

Prompt: To understand their group learning experiences, what is the task and what do they need to do.

- 5. You mentioned you were doing ..., can you tell me when did you learn from that, where you used to apply it?
 - a. Gather key information
 - b. Identifying key issues
 - c. Generate ideas
 - d. Deciding
 - e. Evaluate
 - f. Communicate
 - g. Analysing
 - h. Arguing
 - i. Explain
 - j. Debate
 - k. Reasoning
 - I. Researching
 - m. Reading
 - n. Reflecting

Prompt: To understand their words that capture critical thinking processes

6. Do you think you have learned more from the group compared to doing it alone?

Prompt: Some may not be a fan of group work/group learning, to probe reasons for preference.

- 7. Did you feel that cooperative/ group learning:
 - a. reinforced your personal learning.
 - b. increased your level of performance.
 - c. increased your level of ability
 - d. encouraged critical thinking and problem solving skills
 - e. stimulated self confidence
 - f. Motivating one another
 - g. Encouraged interdependency

Prompt: To understand their perceived benefits of doing group work/group learning.

- 9. What do you understand by critical thinking and problem solving skills? Prompt: To see how participants explain their understanding about the two skills above.
- 10. Do you feel cooperative learning/ group learning is an appropriate method for promoting critical thinking and problem solving skills? Why/Why not?

Prompt: See if the interviewee can expand upon this.

11. How do you go about solving a problem?

Prompt: To understand the process of deriving a solution, it may display critical thinking processes.

- a. Getting ideas from group members
- b. Solve the problem yourself
- c. Have an orderly way of deriving the solution.
- d. Discussing with others
- e. Listening and digesting what is heard/learned
- f. Debate and compromise with ideas
- g. Evaluating others' arguments
- h. Researching the subject matter etc.
